Since 2010, Nicki has been publishing full-length novels and short stories. She has established her own imprint, North Star Press, and continues to write the stories she loves.

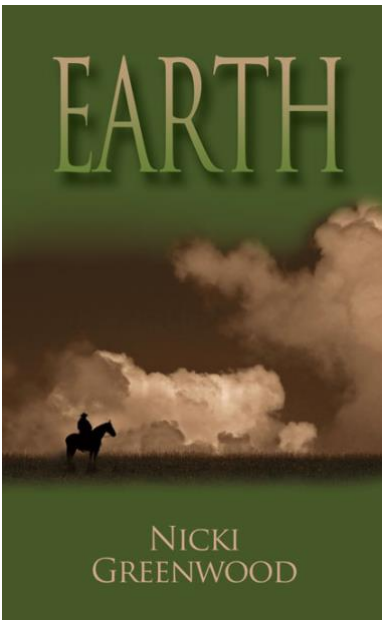
